### PERFORMING ARTS

- Every participant **MUST** complete a "TALENTscape" application form. If performing as part of a group, an application must be completed for each participant. \*
- All lyrics (if applicable) must be typed out. Lyrics and song choice are subject to BGCGW approval.
- Any group acts must not exceed 5 members
- When recording video:
  - ◊ Be sure your lighting and audio are bright and clear—voice should be louder than music
  - ◊ Be aware of your background (i.e. pets, younger siblings, etc.)
  - ◊ Please practice social distancing in your videos. We reserve the right to not include the act if this guideline is not followed.
- Acts must be a minimum of 3 minutes not to exceed 5 minutes.

### VISUAL ARTS

- Every participant **MUST** complete a "TALENTscape" application form. \*
- Artists may work in any medium they choose (i.e. paint, textiles, pastels, etc.)
- Each piece must be the original work of the Club member with no physical assistance from staff, family or peers.
- Artwork must be submitted as a pdf or jpeg file and sent as an attachment to Terri Johnson, [tjohnson@bgcgw.org](mailto:tjohnson@bgcgw.org).

### STEM

- Every participant **MUST** complete a "TALENTscape" application form. \*
- Group projects are accepted. Every participant in the group **MUST** complete a "TALENTscape" application form.
- An outline of the STEM project must be submitted via email to Terri Johnson, [tjohnson@bgcgw.org](mailto:tjohnson@bgcgw.org).
